Central America: Pray for thousands of people in Guatemala impacted by Hurricane Agatha Fri., May 28. Recovery efforts have been hindered by a volcano eruption just 24 hours earlier, on Thursday. Many people had to be evacuated; death tolls are not final. At this time, FMWM has not received any reports from FM leaders in Guatemala regarding the well being of the 1,200 members of the 11 organized FM churches. Surrounding nations, including parts of Mexico, Honduras and El Salvador, were also pounded with as much as 20 inches of rain and were on the watch for flash floods and mudslides as the storms moved off.
